The Advisory Committee is charged with the responsibility of acting as Advisors to the CCCTA Board of Directors, and of collecting and reporting service issues and concerns received from the jurisdictions. The Advisory Committee is charged with the responsibility of acting as disseminators of information to their community, and of assisting in the education of their jurisdictions regarding the fixed-route and assessable services that are available.

Duties: The primary purpose of the CCCTA Advisory Committee will be to review, analyze and advise the County Connection Board of Directors

The Advisory Committee shall be comprised of eleven (11) members from Central Contra Costa County. The City of Clayton may recommend one member for appointment. Members will be appointed for a two year term without compensation. Meetings are held monthly at the CCCTA offices in Concord on Friday mornings from 9:30-11:30 a.m.
