- CalFire Assistant Chief Mike Marcucci will explain what happens in an emergency, discuss the greatest areas of fire risk within our community, and outline the pluses and minuses of a planned evacuation drill.
- Fire Prevention Technician Kathy Woofter will present “Bay Area on Fire,” wildland fire safety and defensible space, as it pertains to Clayton.
- Assistant Chief Terrance Carey of Contra Costa County Fire Protection District’s EMS Division will be available to answer questions about CCCFPD operations in Clayton.
- Emergency Planning Coordinator Meredith Gerhardt, Contra Costa County Office of the Sheriff, Emergency Services Division will present on General Emergency Preparedness
- Sr. Emergency Planning Coordinator, Livia Pop, Contra Costa County Office of the Sheriff, will present the Emergency Alert System, how the alert system works, the types of alerts, how you should respond to them. Instructions/opportunity to register for alerts will be provided.
